

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Internship Duration:

4-8 Weeks/1 Hour Weekly

Student Age: 14 to 18 Years

Internship Mode: Virtual/Hybrid

Matching Objective:

Hands on work experience by interning with a company.

Internship Outcome:

Project presentation, internship certificate, professional network.





INTERNSHIP PROGRAM PROCESS

Project Details:

1 host company professional is allocated to 1 student

Matching Process: Professional and student is matched based on student's interest and professional's expertise

Kickoff Meeting: 1st online meeting hosted by YFS between mentor and student

Catch Up Meeting:

Weekly meetings between mentor and student to report work progress and internship reflection

Final Presentation:

Student delivers final presentation to host company representatives and reflect on the process





PROFESSIONAL'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The host company professional acts as mentor & supervisor to set project delivery expectations and provide feedback through the internship process.

Contact Hours:

1 Hours Weekly for 4-8 Weeks

Mentorship:

Support & guide the student to develop their ideas and complete the project.

Projects:

Company can choose from a list of templated projects which can be customized if required.

Sharing:

Share career development and industry knowledge
